

OSDFS PARTNERSHIPS IN CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM (CFDA #84.215S AND 84.215V) GRANT AWARDS ANNOUNCED

The Partnerships in Character Education Program has awarded four new grantees for FY 2004. These grants enable eligible state and local education agencies to design and implement character education programs in grades K-12. Grant recipients must show how they have integrated character education into classroom instruction and teacher training, and that they have involved parents, students and the community in the process. Since 2002, the Department has awarded 55 grants to states and local school districts for a total of 101 grants. A total of one state education agency and three local education agencies were selected from this competition.
